

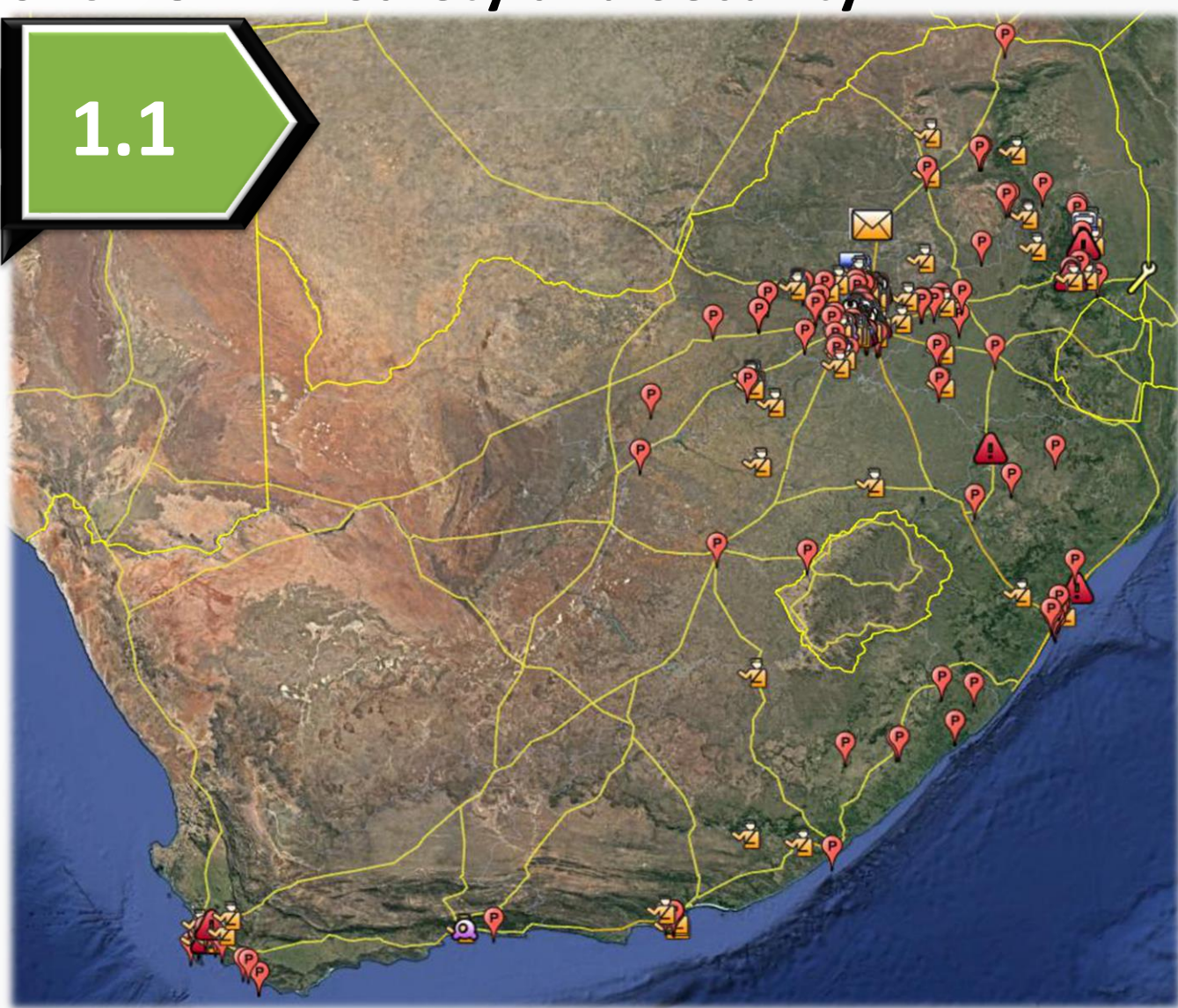

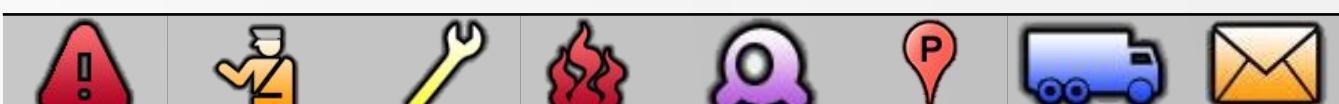

Accused to appear in court on charges of attempted murder, kidnapping and assault with intent to do grievous bodily harm when they forced Victor Mlotshwa into a coffin

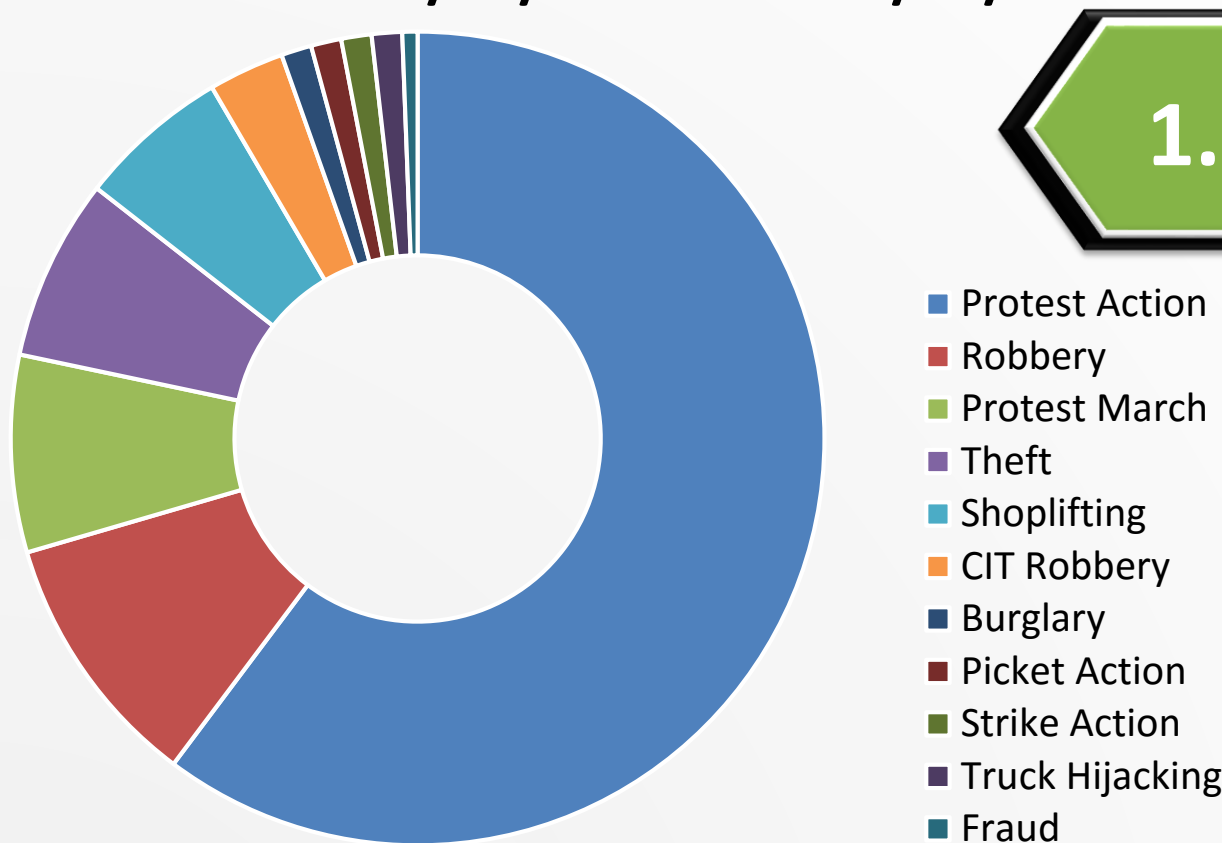

Risks: Arson and barricading of roads

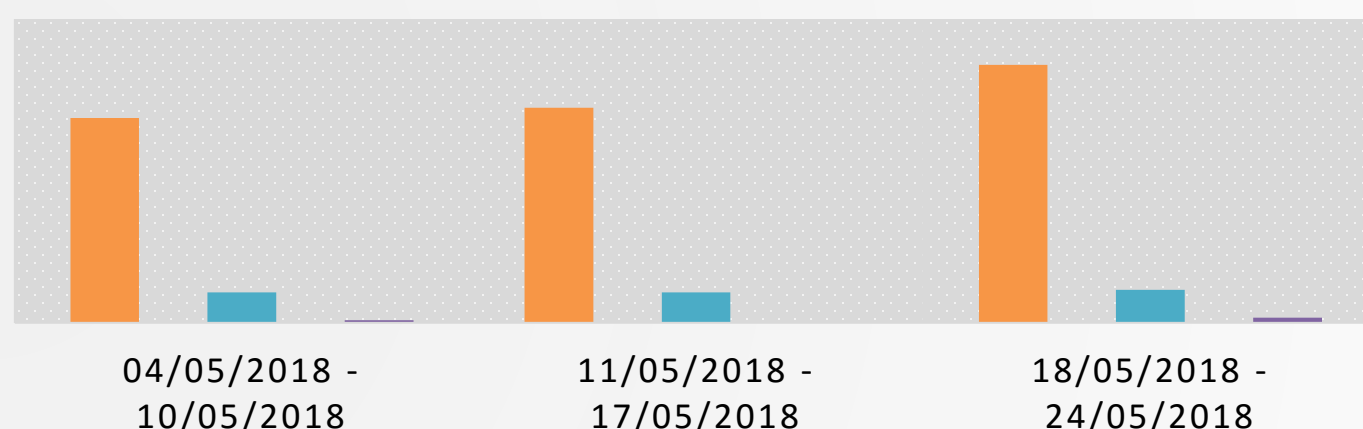
Distribution of recorded incidents according to type from 18/05/2018 until 24/05/2018

The **Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF)** is encouraging residents of Angelo, Jerusalem and Delmore Park informal settlements to **occupy municipal-owned land** as the informal settlements are allegedly at risk for flooding and sink holes

Risks:

Arson, malicious damage to property, barricading of roads (Main Reef Road/R29, Station and Wit Deep Roads) and clashes between police and demonstrators

High-risk locations: Angelo and Delmore Park informal settlements (Balmoral, Boksburg) and Jerusalem informal settlement (Angelo, Boksburg)

Service delivery related protest action probable in Vusimuzi (Tembisa, Gauteng)

Dissatisfaction with City of Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality's alleged failure to relocate occupants after **several structures were damaged by flooding**

Risks: Barricading of roads, intimidation and **malicious damage to property (pelted vehicles with stones)**

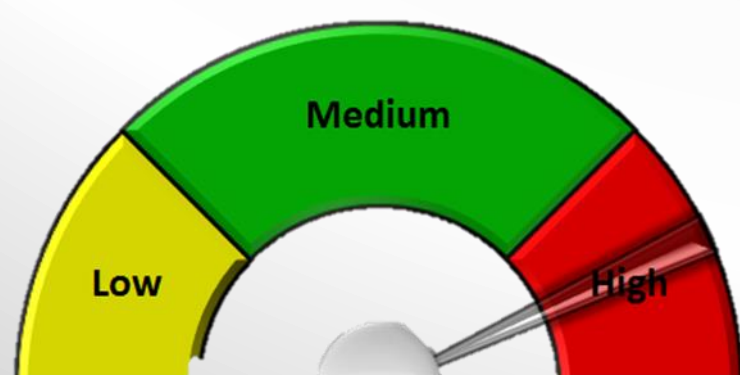

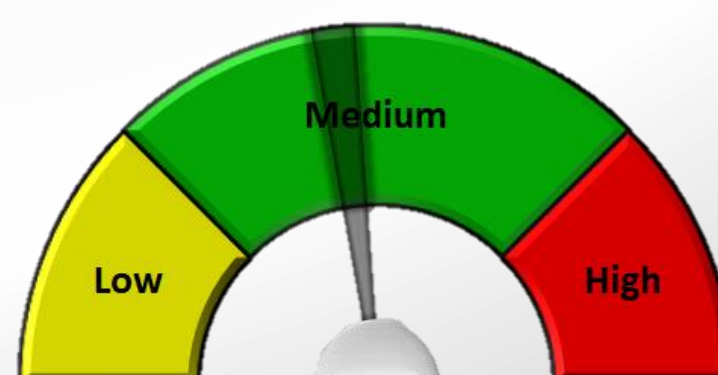
