




To demand that fuel levies be reduced by 20%, as well as that the Road Accident Fund (RAF) be placed under administration to reduce corruption and improve management

> **Risks** during demonstration: Heavy foot traffic, loitering and intimidation


Distribution of recorded incidents according to type from 20/07/2018 until 26/07/2018


