Health & Safety Policy Statement

- Protect workers from reprisals when reporting incidents, hazards, risks and opportunities.
- Ensure consultation and participation of employees, and, where they exist, employees' representatives.
- Seek continual improvement in our health and safety performance and management through regular (at least annual) reviews and revision of this policy.
- Control and reduce the exposure to ergonomic risks in the workplace.
- Provide the resource required to make this policy and our Health and Safety arrangements effective.

The Management Team aims to maintain the trust and respect of all stakeholders and communities in the area in which we conduct business, and to support and comply with the relevant legal- and other requirements, human rights and labour standards. We also recognize our duty to co-operate and work with other employers when we work at premises or sites under their control to ensure the continued health and safety of all those at work, and our duty to co-operate and work with other employers and their workers, when their workers come onto our premises or sites to do work for us, to ensure the health and safety of everyone at work.

Occupational, Health and Safety Objectives and Targets Framework:

- Ensure a healthy and safe environment for all employees, customers, and the public, as is reasonably practicable.
- Ensure that the workplace is safe and healthy by conducting risk assessments and safe work procedures according to the tasks being performed.

- Reduce the cost and time spent investigating incidents, accidents, and non-conformance.
- Participation-based safety approach.

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
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
